

Burning Tree Pool Rules

Covid 19 Precautions

All Burning Tree Pool patrons, guests and staff are required to follow the rules and regulations set forth by pool management. These rules are posted at the pool.

Patrons and guests that violate the rules are subject to be temporarily or permanently barred from the use of the pool. Enforcement of the rules is carried out by pool managers and staff.

Entry Procedure: All Homeowners and their families, and guests are required to check in at the pool front desk to sign in and have their memberships verified every visit.

- Upon entering facilities all patrons must use hand sanitizer prior to signing in.
- A quick health screening will be completed by BTP Staff: Screen/question customers, employees and vendors for symptoms. (cough, fever, shortness of breath, close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- You may stay with your family and move lounge chairs but once you have chosen the area that you will be sitting, you must remain there for the remainder of your visit to the pool.
- Burning Tree Staff will sanitize tables, chairs, lounge chairs, and bathrooms before allowing another guest to use that same chair, table, lounge chair, shower, or restroom.
- You must be a minimum of 6' from other guests in and out of the water.
- All Patrons must take a cleansing shower, using warm water and soap before entering the pool. We will be limiting patrons to 3 persons entering the rest room at one time to maintain 6' social distancing recommendations until restrictions are lifted.
- 6' social distancing recommendations must be maintained at the slide, diving board, lifeguard stand, and concession stand.
- Bathing load will be decreased by half (90) until restrictions are lifted due to Covid 19 precautions.
- One guest at a time at concession stand
- **Swim diapers must be worn by children or babies that are not potty trained while in the pool. (you may purchase one at the concession stand)**
- No tobacco products, No Smoking or Vaping inside of the BTP gated property.
- Persons with open wounds, bandages, or any symptom of communicable disease shall be prevented from entering the pool.
- Running and rough play are prohibited in and around the pool area. Any acts of "horseplay" that the lifeguards or pool staff feels endangers persons or property will not be permitted.

- Only approved swimwear will be allowed in the pool. No cut-offs or thong bikinis.
- No one is allowed in the pool when lifeguards are not in the pool area.
- Excess body lotions should be removed prior to entering the water.
- No glass of any kind is allowed in pool area.
- BTP Staff will sanitize chairs and tables and bathrooms between each patron use.
- One person on slide at a time, you may not be on the stairs until the person in front of you has entered the water and you may not go down the slide until that person has reached the side of the pool. Feet first only going down the slide.
- One approach and one bounce only on diving board, forward facing dives and jumps only.
- Do not step onto diving board until person in front of you had entered the water and do not enter water until that person has reached the side of the pool.
- **No floatation devices (rings, water wings, lifejackets) are allowed on the diving board or slide, or in the deep end of the pool.**
- Free-floating objects used by small children are allowed with adult supervision.
- You may not wait at the bottom of the slide or diving board to assist; you must be completely to the pool side.
- No goggles or masks may be worn while using the slide or diving board.
- No chewing gum in pool area.
- Profanity and offensive language will not be tolerated.
- **Children must be 12 years old and prove swimming proficiency to be left alone at the pool.**
- Parents are responsible for children in the wading pool area ***Notice* THERE IS NOT A LIFEGAUARD ON DUTY***. No one 8 years of age or older is allowed in the wading pool area, there must be an adult supervising any child in the wading pool area.
- When lightning is observed or thunder is heard by lifeguards or pool management, the pool must be cleared until lightning or thunder is absent for 30 minutes.
- The pool may be cleared of all people at the discretion of any Burning Tree Staff.
- All accidents and injuries must be reported to Burning Tree Pool Staff immediately.
- Skates, Skateboards, nor pets shall be allowed in the pool area. No bicycles in pool area.
- Burning Tree Master Association/Burning Tree Pool is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Members/Guests shall be liable for damages to all Association property done by them or their guests.
- If these rules and precautions are not followed, you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately. Pool staff have the authority to discipline anyone who fails to comply with the rules and is not acting properly or is being offensive in any way.
- Burning Tree Pool staff are dedicated to maintaining the health and safety of all our patrons.
